Since Early September we have been hiking into a tiny village church in the community of N'Baranat to minister to the small group of believers who have been meeting there, but have had no pastor. On our way we have encountered a snake, have had to wait for long lines of cows to clear the path, and carry ponchos in case we are caught by the rain. The obstacles are worth the journey. Lively singing precedes our arrival and we squeeze into a 15'x30'leaky roof, dirt floor SANCTUARY! Here the praises and

prayers lifted up to our Lord are offered as a sweet aroma. Jeff has begun teaching the basics of the faith and will be presenting a modified Old Testament Survey. The interaction he has with the congregation is encouraging as good questions are asked and many are eager to learn.
